





<b>Learner's Permit (L plates)</b>	<b>Learn to drive (Log Book)</b>	<b>Hazard Perception Test (HPT)</b>	<b>Gain driving experience (Log Book)</b>	<b>Practical Driving Test (PDA)</b>	<b>Provisional Licence (P plates)</b>
<p>16 years of age (minimum age)</p> <p>Pass the Learner's Permit Test as a Computerised Theory Test (CTT) at a Transport Driver and Vehicle Services (DVS) Centre, Transport regional office or DVS agent, or at school as part of the <i>Keys for Life</i> program.</p> <p>Apply and pay for a Learner's Permit and Log Book after declaring any medical conditions, presenting five Proof of Identity (POI) forms, and passing an eyesight test at a DVS Centre, regional office or DVS agent.</p> <p>A photo will be taken and a Learner's Permit (card) issued, which will remain valid for 3 years.</p>	<p>Undertake driving lessons with a supervisor (and where possible, a professional driving instructor).</p> <p>Display L plates and carry the Learner's Permit card at all times when driving.</p> <p>Progress at a rate suitable to the learner driver's skills and knowledge.</p> <p>Begin recording 50 hours of supervised driving, including a minimum of 5 hours night driving, in your Log Book.</p> <p>Record any driving lesson of 10 minutes duration or longer in the Log Book.</p> <p>Drive at or below the posted speed limit.</p> <p>When ready, learn to drive on a freeway, at or below 100km/h, even when the posted limit is 110km/h.</p> <p>Do not drive in Kings Park.</p> <p>Always drive with a 0.00 Blood Alcohol Concentration (0.00% BAC).</p> <p>Demerits points apply.</p>	<p>16 years and 6 months of age (minimum age)</p> <p>Ensure six months has lapsed</p> <p>Sit and pay for the Hazard Perception Test.</p>	<p>Continue recording 50 hours of supervised driving, including a minimum of 5 hours night driving, in your Log Book.</p> <p>Display L plates and carry the Learner's Permit card at all times when driving.</p> <p>Record any driving session of 10 minutes duration or longer in the Log Book.</p> <p>Drive at or below the posted speed limit.</p> <p>When driving on freeways or open roads drive at, or below, 100km/h even when the posted limit is 110km/h.</p> <p>Do not drive in Kings Park.</p> <p>Always drive with a 0.00 Blood Alcohol Concentration (0.00% BAC).</p> <p>Demerits points apply.</p>	<p>17 years of age (minimum age)</p> <p>Present the completed 50 hour Log book and proof of identity.</p> <p>Book and sit the Practical Driving Assessment at the DVS Centre, regional office or DVS agent.</p>	<p>A Provisional driver's licence will be issued at a minimum age of 17 years.</p> <p>Drive unsupervised as a Provisional driver, displaying red P plates for the first 6 months followed by green P plates for the final 18 months. (A full licence can be issued at a minimum age of 19 years).</p> <p>Drive at, or below, the posted speed limit and to the prevailing conditions.</p> <p>Always drive with a 0.00 Blood Alcohol Concentration (0.00% BAC).</p> <p>Demerits points apply.</p> <p>Do not drive between midnight and 5am while on red P plates, unless an exemption has been granted.</p>
